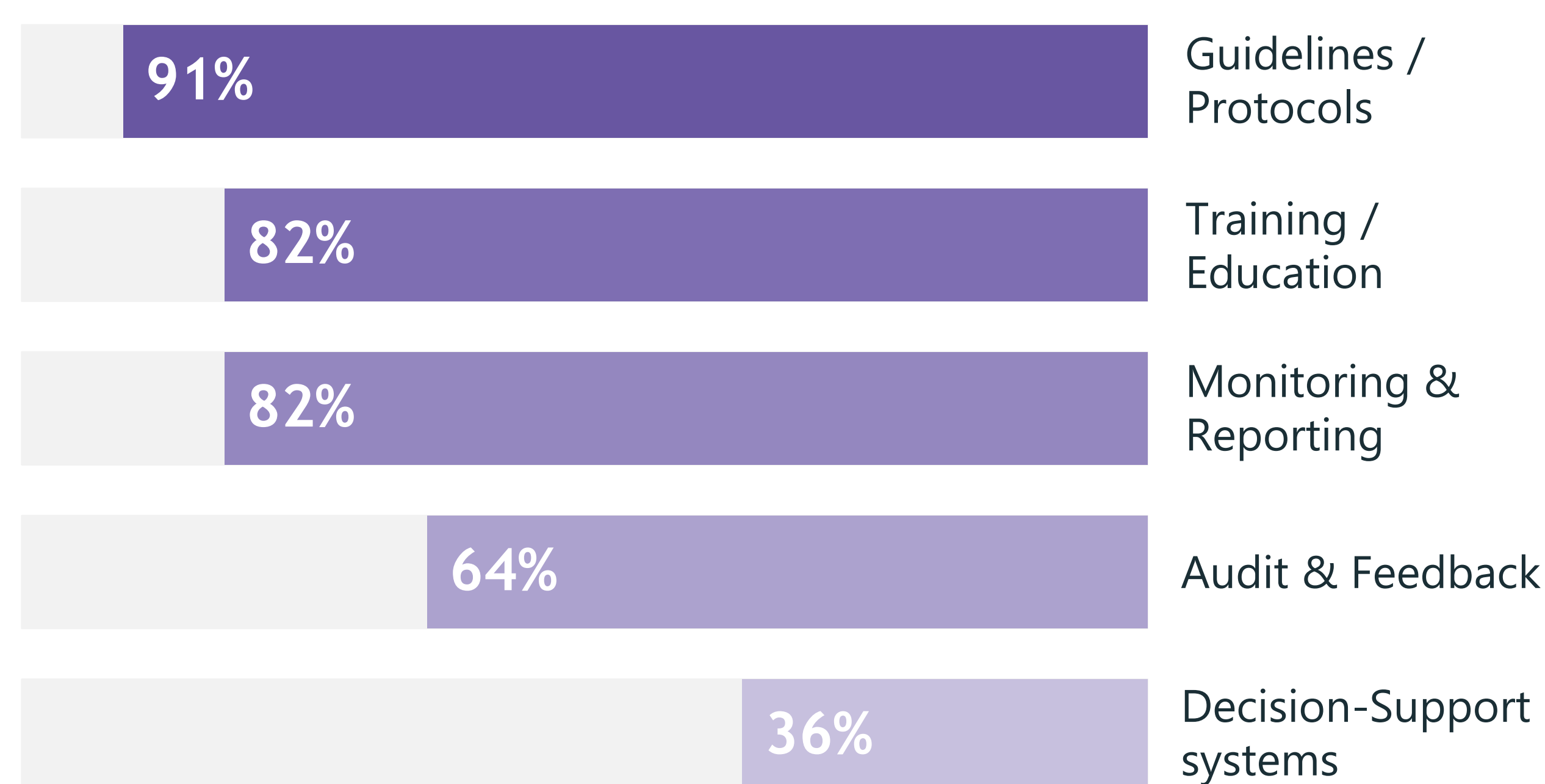

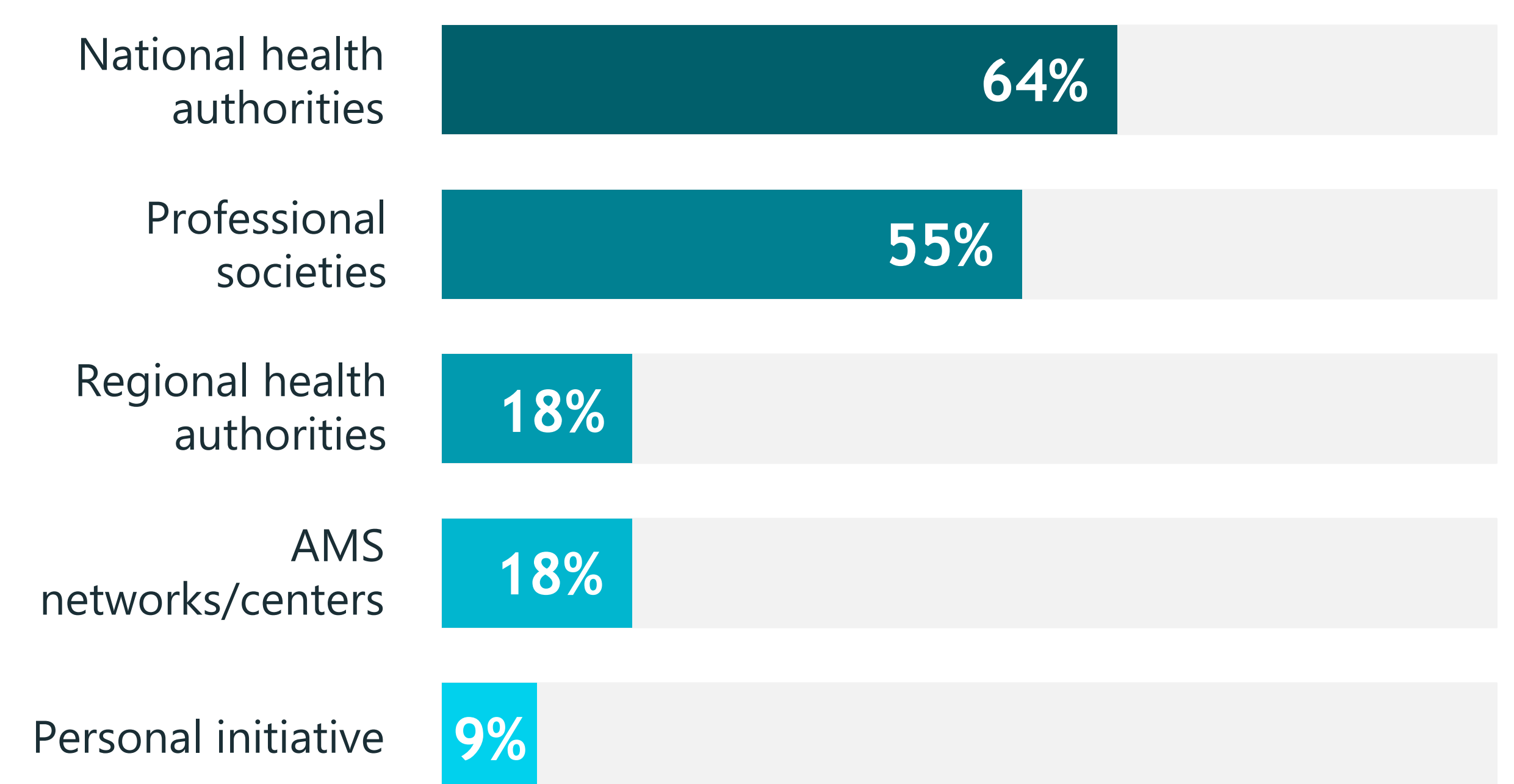
The ESGAP network sought to map existing national AMS tool repositories across member countries.

### AMS TOOLS IDENTIFIED IN EXISTING NATIONAL REPOSITORIES (N=11)



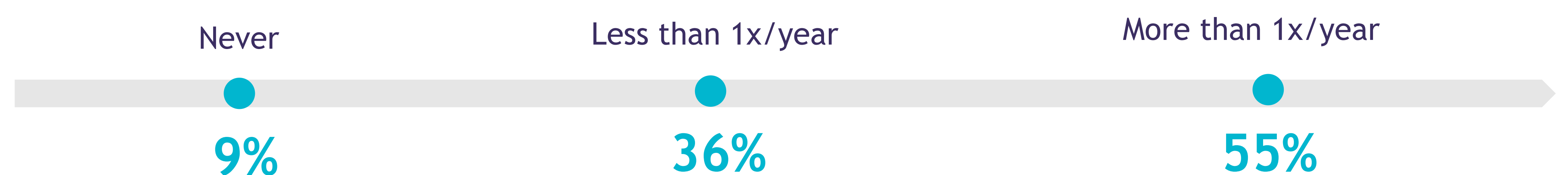
### LEADERSHIP MODELS (N=11)
